Report

Last Saturday the 23rd of March the 2nd Pairs Day for the 2019 year was run at the TPVRC Loomberah Range.

It was another great attendance for the shoot with 26 in total and that was with 4-6 of the club's regular pair shooters not being able to attend. So, we will have to wait until the 29th of June for the next Pairs to see if we can crack the 30 mark.

The range looked great on the day with shooting being from the 500m bench facility. The 50m rimfire range was set up and run off benches 1 through to 4 complete with wind flags and a great target system allowing 2 x details to go through before targets needed to be changed out.

The 500m centrefire was run from the 5 through to 8 benches. It was great to see the range in full operation with both rim and centrefire operating together to complete the course. Lots of shooting and lots of fun. It really is a combined effort of all the members to make a shoot like this work and this was the case on Saturday.

A big thanks needs to go to all who helped set up and pack up on the day. I think everyone present was involved in some way. Special thanks to Andrew McDonald for implementing a great idea to hold the corflute's in place and to Norm Ekman for his heavy duty corflute sheets as the backers for the targets. Also, thanks to Rob Jones for again manufacturing and donating another set of awesome trophies for the shoot. These were awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters.

At the end of the day the Father and son team of Dean and Lindsay Dewhurst were stoked to take home the chockies after some tense moments with ammo in the rimfire. Lindsay also posted a great score in the 500m section of 97.0 shot with a .223, which made all the difference.

Second place went to Andrew McDonald and Peter Barnier only a couple of points behind. Peter shot the best rim and centrefire score of the day as well as the smallest rimfire group on his B target which had all 5 rounds through one hole in the centre. Great shooting.

Third place went to Rob and Cheryl Jones, only one point behind 2nd place. X count was high and so was the competition. Conditions again weren't that favorable, so these scores are fantastic.

This is your opportunity to get familiar with this target at this distance, get sight settings and test a load due to the bullet weight restrictions if you are intending on participating in the Long Tan match.

The deliberate will be run on the Type B target which is also a great chance to get a rifle sorted for the ANZAC Matches.

There will be another zero and practice day for the ANZAC Matches on Saturday the 20th of April.

The range will be open from 12.30 pm for sign in and prep with standard range fees applying.
