Last Saturday the 6th of April had a 300m Field Class practice on the program which gave the opportunity for members to get prone, off a sling and shoot the 22-shot match. Included in the practice was also the chance to get familiar with and zero a rifle on the Figure 11 service targets at the 300m range.

This is due to these Figure 11 targets being used for the new Long Tan Match which will be run at the ANZAC Memorial Matches to be held on Saturday the 27th of April.

The Memorial Matches will be a big day with four perpetual trophies to be awarded as well as prizes AND, as mentioned the new Long Tan Match.

The Long Tan trophy is just about completed and let me tell you folks that it is something that the TPVRC and all its members can be proud of and all that it represents. The take home trophy for the winner is just as inspiring and from all reports the match has already raised some considerable interest amongst the members already preparing rifles, sights and ammunition.

The 200m Field practice will kick off at approximately 1-1:30pm after the conclusion of the working bee. Standard range fees will apply.

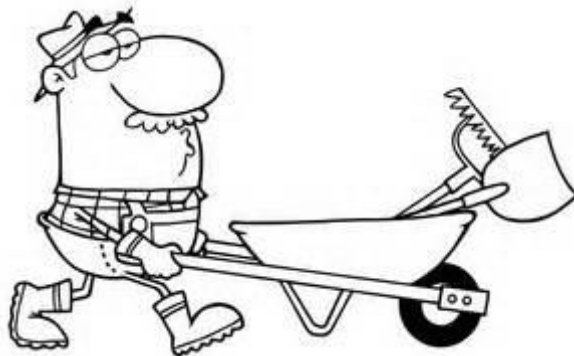

Arrangements for the dozer to be in use have been made which will see the back stop as well as a bit of a touch up of the 300m mound and time permitting the 200m mound.

There is always heaps to do, if you can spare some time on the day then it would be greatly appreciated. Please bring along a rake if you have one as the 300 and 200m

mounds will be getting a re structure for a better camber and dirt will be required to be hand dressed after the dozer has done its thing.

A BBQ lunch will be supplied for all workers at the bee as well as tea and coffee available in the club house.
