TPVRC AGM and Service Rifle Prize Shoot this Saturday the 23rd February

The first prize shoot of the year will be run this Saturday the 23rd of February which will also be the chance to give the service rifles a run after a big start to the year with optics.

The Prize Shoot will be made up of two details in total. 1 x 300m deliberate application of a total of 15 rounds being; 3 x optional warm up shots, followed by 2 x non convertible sighting shots and then 10 x shots for a score. The second detail will be a Snap Fire which will be 2 x non convertible sighting shots followed by 10 x shots, snap fire, for a score.

Classes of rifle will be any as issued iron sight rifle and any as issued rifle with optics limited to 6x power. Match iron and match optical rifles will also be catered for.



All shooting will be from the 300m mound, prone position with sling support only. As issued rifles will be allowed the use of front sand bags however that is it and no other rests are allowed in any other classes. Target will be the Type B 4x4 for both details.

Entry fee for the day is \$25 per shooter. All entrants will get a pick of the prize table. Nibbles will be supplied at the presentation and AGM. The usual cold refreshments will be available for purchase.

Range open time will be from 11.30am for sign in and prep with the matches to get under way as soon as possible after that to ensure enough time for the AGM.



The AGM will be held on range in the clubhouse at the close of the prize table pick and presentation. Hoping we can get as many members there as possible because as usual there will be all the important business to cover and discuss. The agenda for the 2019 AGM is attached to this newsletter as well as the minutes from last year's AGM for all members to familiarize themselves with.

The first “Pairs Shoot” for the year was run on Saturday the 9th of February where the biggest attendance to the range was seen for some time. 28 shooters were in attendance for the match and it was excellent to see the largest number of ladies and also junior shooters at the range for as long as the committee could remember.

The “Pairs” is the chance for the members to team up with a partner or fellow member of their choosing and then both members of the Pairs shoot a 50m Rimfire event followed by a 500m Centrefire event for a score out of a possible combined score of 400.40.

The shooting was conducted from the undercover 500m bench facility which again has been great in being able to get in some shooting in this hot weather.

Trophies were awarded to the 1st, 2nd and third place pairs. Thanks again to Rob Jones for the supply of these trophies which looked great and very much appreciated.

A big thank you also to **Calibre Country** for their donation of a pair of quality earmuffs which were awarded as an encouragement award to junior shooter Olivia Leckie who paired up with her Dad; Hugh. Well done.

Congratulations to Rob and Cheryl Jones for taking out first place on the day with a clear and convincing grand aggregate score of 396.14. Second place went to Rowan and Jess Urquhart with another excellent score of 386.16 and third place went to Lindsay and Dean Dewhurst with a 384.13.

The Ladies and the juniors dominated the rimfire match with Cheryl Jones, Jess Urquhart, Abby Ulman (J) and Lindsay Dewhurst (J) all shooting possible scores of 100+ for their two targets. Rob Jones shot the only possible score in the 500m centre fire with a 100.05.

There were two awesome groups shot on the day in the rimfire and could not be split. Andrew McDonald and David Gulliford both shot a .349” group in the rimfire which is great shooting considering the conditions. Well done. Full scores are tabled below

The next Pairs is set down for the 23rd of March where again the committee is hoping for another good turnout, maybe even better as the temperature and conditions will be very different and a lot more comfortable. Hope to see you there.
