Report

Another great night of shooting was had last Saturday the 2nd of March where the second TPVRC Night Shoot for the 2019 year was run.

Fourteen members were in attendance where 2 x details of 2 x targets for each detail were shot for a grand aggregate out of a possible 200.20. Classes on offer were any caliber rifle, (adhering to range regulations), and two classes of optics being less than 14 power and greater than 14 power.

Congratulations to Peter Barnier for scoring highest on the night in the greater than 14 power optic class with a score of 192.02. Second place went to Rob Jones shooting a 191.02 and third place was John Barnier with a 188.03.

There was only one shooter in the less than 14 power class, and this was Ted Cutler. Ted shot a very respectable score of 172.01 with the lower powered optics.

Special mention must go to Max Collins for shooting the only possible target score of the night which was a neat 50.00 on his D target. Max also registered the smallest group of the shoot on this target which measured 1.45". Well done and great shooting.

A big thanks also to Rob Jones for donating and manufacturing the trophies that were awarded on the night. Much appreciated and thanks for your support mate.

Thanks also to all the members who helped on the night with the set up and pack up of equipment. It all makes for a safe and enjoyable match.

<u>This Saturday the 9th of March</u> has a 200 and 100m Field Class practice on the program where the full course will be shot at each distance. Members will require at least 22 rounds at <u>each</u> distance which is shot in 5 round strings and from the seated

position at 200m and then the standing position at 100m.

Sling support is allowed but the Field Class discipline does not allow any specialized shooting aids such as gloves, specialized shooting coats or mats. There is no limit on optical power and any calibre up to 8mm can be used.

<u>Please note</u> that a new Bench Tactical Class is available in the Field Class and was trialed at last years Field Class Queens in Coffs Harbour. The class is only open to shooters over the age of 65yrs or for those who are incapacitated by a medical condition or injury.

Basically, the match can be shot from the prone position with the rifle supported at the front or from a bench from the seated position. This is the case for all range distances. The target is also greatly reduced in size with a 1" or less centre V bull.

The range will be open from 12.30 for sign in and prep with the practice to get under way shortly after. Standard range fees will apply.

"Pairs Day" not far away

The second "Pairs Day" for the year is set down for the 23rd of March and if the first is anything to go by this one should be a cracker with cooler weather and hopefully friendlier conditions.

The "Pairs" has been a surprise to all as it brings out some friendly rivalry amongst the members and even between the team mates as the shooters try to out shoot each other in the 50m rimfire and 500m centre fire matches.

Start getting your equipment and pairs sorted now.
