Some of the work set down is repairs to the butts area where new timber is to be put into the mantlet for reinforcement and repair. There is dozer work required on back stop, mantlet and 300m mound, also, new flag poles are to be installed at 500, 300, 200 and 100m mounds as well as the back stop pole to get a facelift. As I said, a massive amount of work so if you can spare some time then it would be greatly appreciated.

Already there is thanks to Ross Taylor for picking up and delivering the repair timber sections to the range which have already been positioned for install. Cheers mate.
